Place your garbage out for collection at the designated point by 8:30 am on collection day.






• Bulky items are collected 4 times per year. Please confirm the dates for your neighborhood on the Garbage Collection Calendar. Please pay handling fees upon collection. 520 yen for 1 item, and 310 yen for each additional item. E.g. 3 items = 520 + (2x310) = 1,140 yen



- caramel cups packaging & fruit ne Do not dispose of these items as burnable garbage.
- Do not put items within plastic bags inside the designated bag. Tie or ball-up plastic bags.
- Please place plastic items in the designated bag in such a way that they can be seen clearly.
- Please make sure to completely use up the contents and, if necessary, rinse the item before disposing.
- Please separate the caps from bottles/tubes.
- $\triangle$  Please be aware that not every item made of plastic is classified as plastic garbage. Toothbrushes, hangers, buckets and toys are considered burnable garbage. If in doubt, consult the A-Z Garbage Separation and Disposal List.

### **Ceramic and Glass Items**

- Dispose of ceramic and glass items on the same day as non-burnable garbage
- collection day.
- Place ceramic and glass items in a bag (any kind) to dispose.
- Broken items are accepted.
- If an item as is poses a danger (e.g.
- sharp glass shards), wrap it in newspaper.

### **Collection Not Possible**

Calls to reserve garbage pickup are only accepted on weekday mornings Please make sure to call by noon of the day before collection day to reserve. Place the garbage outside your home by the agreed pickup time. Organize pickup with Nakao on 08387-2-1701



## **Recyclables** (1)

- Recyclable garbage is collected once per month (please refer to the Garbage Collection Calendar).
- Please place each item in the appropriate collection crate provided at the collection point.
- Please remove any leftover contents and rinse before disposal.

#### Cans

- Rinse and place in the crate. You do not need to squash it.
- There is no need to separate between aluminium, tin and steel etc.
- Use up spray cans entirely and pierce a hole in them before disposal.

A Paint cans, spray paint cans and ittokans are classified as non-burnable garbage

⚠ Dispose of can lids (ring-pull lids etc.) and metal bottle caps as non-burnable garbage

#### Glass Bottles

- Glass bottles are separated into 3 kinds: ① clear (transparent),② brown, and ③ other colors
- Broken bottles are accepted.
- mark→ ♠ PET Bottles

#### • Remove the cap and label film (these go in plastic garbage)

 Rinse the bottle and squash it before disposal. • Any other plastic bottles (e.g. condiment, sauce, cooking oil, detergent, shampoo, make-up, medicine), with the exception of soy sauce bottles, are classified as plastic garbage unless they have the PET mark pictured above.

#### White Polystyrene Food Trays

- Remove any wrapping, labels or stickers.
- Wash before disposal. Do not fold.

Items Collected: paper and card wrapping, packaging and containers, newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes

Box mouth

Collection Time: Opening hours of the respective collection site

#### Small Household Appliances Collection Points

- Collection Points: Hagi Secondary Recycling Center, branch offices of Hagi City Government
- Items Collected: small household appliances, gadgets and electronics (the box mouth size is 20 cm x 40 cm)
- Collection Time: Opening hours of the respective collection site



#### Used Paper & Clothing

- Make sure to separate the items into their respective kinds and bundle lengthwise and crosswise with string. A collection sticker is not necessary.
- Place items on the plastic sheet provided in at the collection point.
- If it is rainy or rough weather and the collection point has no overhead cover or roofing, please wait until the following month to dispose.




Only corrugated cardboard can be accepted. If it is not corrugated then dispose of as Bundle into stacks around 60 cm in length on each side.



#### **Weekend Disposal**

A temporary garbage collection point is set up at Tamagawa Recycling Center to collect garbage once a month at the weekend from 9:00-12:00 (dates can be found on the Garbage Collection Calendar).

- Please sort and separate your items in advance.
- Place the garbage in their respective designated bags.
- Place ceramic and glass items in a bag (any kind) to dispose. There is no handling fee for recyclable garbage.
- There is a handling fee of 100 yen/10 kg for items which are not disposed of in a designated bag or do not have a collection sticker applied.

#### Private Disposal

It is possible to bring garbage other than burnable garbage\* by yourself to Tamagawa Recycling Center for disposal.

- Please sort and separate your items in advance.
- There is a handling fee of 100 yen/10 kg. There is no handling fee for recyclable garbage.
